## IACS WEBINAR 2024 : AN INSIGHT INTO AI GOVERNANCE ROLE OF CHARTERED SECRETARY

### Introduction

In February 2022, Chartered Governance Institute UK (CGI UK) has published a paper on "Ethical Governance of AI" which provides emphasis on people-centered governance to promote the highest standards of human behaviour around AI development and applications.

According to CGI UK, one may experience fear when starting to work with AI, the fact that the technology is developed from human talent, means that fears and myths, such as that machines will take over human capital or that AI is objective, can only be overcome through gaining more knowledge about the technology. AI has already arrived in the boardroom and will continue into the future. Hybrid approach, therefore, will help boards and practitioners to govern limitations of technology and legal limitations on AI governance, while maintaining human accountability.

According to Ren Bin Lee Dixon (2022) Artificial Intelligence (AI) governance is anticipated to have a transformative impact on humanity which has prompted researchers to analyze its implementation and use to ensure that the technology advances ethically and is beneficial for society. As technology is advancing rapidly and has already caused harm inequitably underrepresented communities, there is an urgent need to establish robust governance to mitigate the issues and risks attendant when deploying AI.
